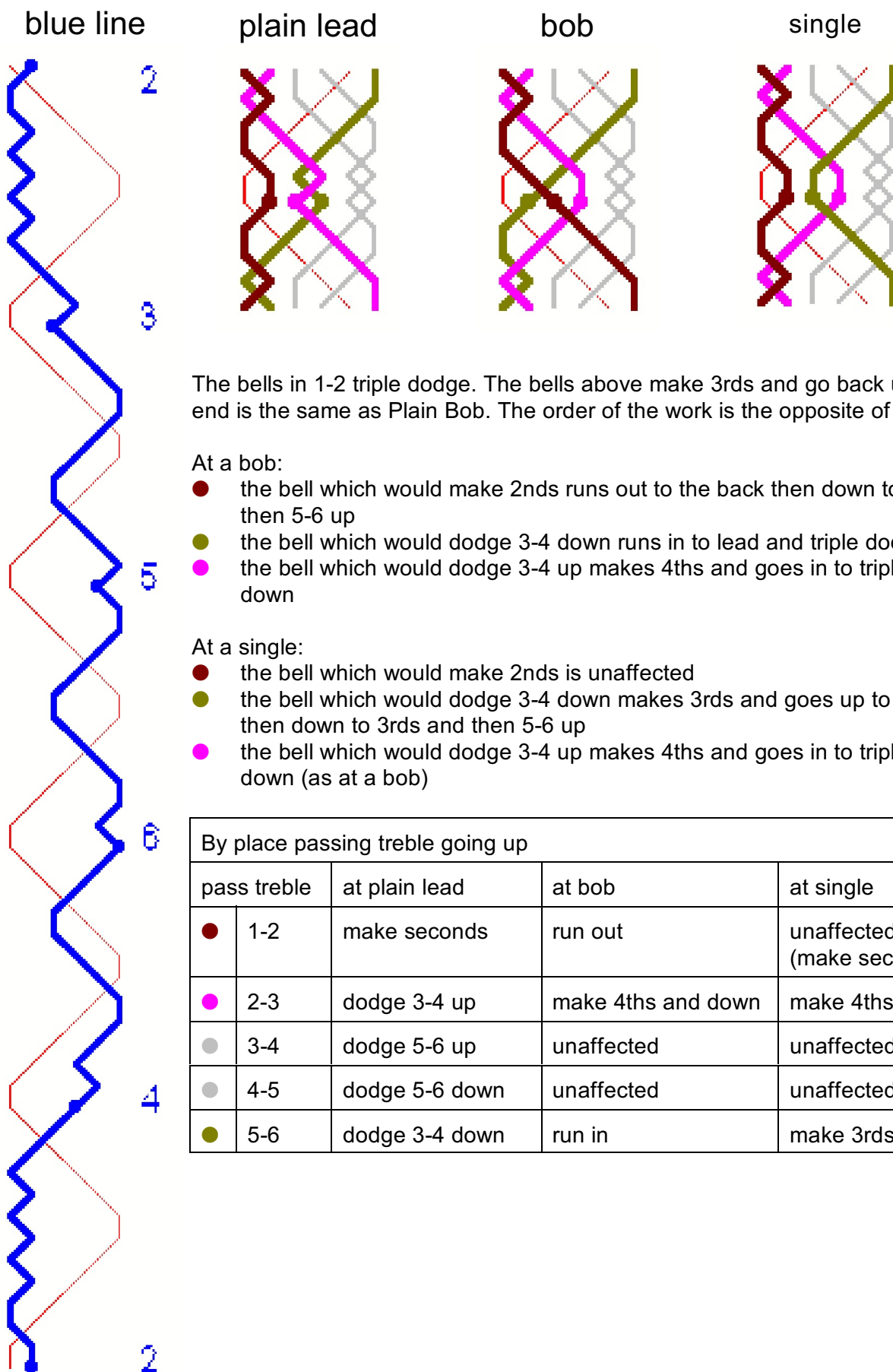


St. Clements Bob Minor

St. Chad's Pattingham Bellringers



The bells in 1-2 triple dodge. The bells above make 3rds and go back up. The lead end is the same as Plain Bob. The order of the work is the opposite of Plain Bob.

At a bob:

- the bell which would make 2nds runs out to the back then down to 3rds and then 5-6 up
- the bell which would dodge 3-4 down runs in to lead and triple dodge 1-2 up
- the bell which would dodge 3-4 up makes 4ths and goes in to triple dodge 1-2 down

At a single:

- the bell which would make 2nds is unaffected
- the bell which would dodge 3-4 down makes 3rds and goes up to the back then down to 3rds and then 5-6 up
- the bell which would dodge 3-4 up makes 4ths and goes in to triple dodge 1-2 down (as at a bob)

By place passing treble going up		at plain lead	at bob	at single
●	1-2	make seconds	run out	unaffected (make seconds)
●	2-3	dodge 3-4 up	make 4ths and down	make 4ths and down
●	3-4	dodge 5-6 up	unaffected	unaffected
●	4-5	dodge 5-6 down	unaffected	unaffected
●	5-6	dodge 3-4 down	run in	make 3rds and up
