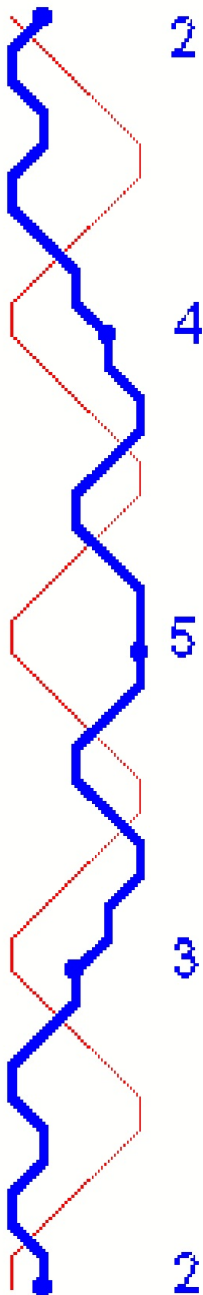
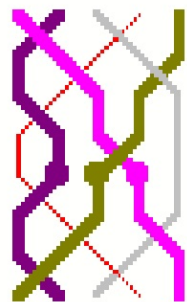


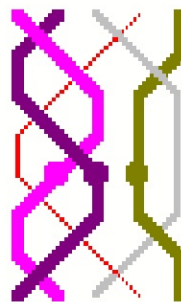

The bells in 1-2 make places (lead 2nds lead). The bells above make 3rds and go back up. The lead end is the same as Reverse Canterbury so the bells in 3-4 make places.

At a bob:

- the bell which would make 2nds makes 3rds and back in to places on the front then 2nds over the treble
- the bell which would make 3-4 places down makes 4 blows in 4ths and goes up
- the bell which would make 3-4 places up makes 3rds and goes in to places on the front then 3-4 up

By place passing treble going up			
	pass treble	at plain lead	at bob
●	1-2	make seconds	3rds and in
●	2-3	3-4 places up	3rds and in
●	3-4	4 blows in 5ths	unaffected
●	4-5	3-4 places down	4 blows in 4ths and up
